Getting started

From sign-up to your first authenticated API call.

Creating your account

Sign up with Google, GitHub, or an email link — a sandbox workspace is created for you automatically.

1. **Go to capitis.app and choose Sign in.**

You can continue with Google, GitHub, or type your email to receive a one-time sign-in link — there is no password to remember.

2. **Complete the provider consent screen (or click the link in your email).**

Tip: The email link arrives from capitis.app within a minute; check spam the first time.

3. **Land on your dashboard.**

On first sign-in we create your publisher workspace and a sandbox API key automatically — nothing to configure.

4. **Follow the "What's next" checklist on the home page.**

It walks you through revealing your API key, creating a tracking link, and registering a webhook.

 *Your account starts in sandbox: full API access with test-safe limits, no billing required.*

Your first API call

Reveal your API key and list merchants with one request.

1. **Open Developer → API keys in the sidebar.**

2. **Reveal your sandbox key.**

 *The full key is shown once. Store it in your secrets manager — after this screen we only display a masked prefix. If you lose it, rotate the key.*

3. **Call the API from your terminal.**

```
curl -H "Authorization: Bearer YOUR_API_KEY" https://api.capitis.app/v1/merchants
```

4. **Explore the full surface in the interactive API reference at capitis.app/docs/api.**

Every endpoint, parameter, and response envelope is documented there from the live OpenAPI spec.

Rotating API keys

Swap a key instantly if it leaks or on a regular schedule.

1. **Open Developer → API keys.**

2. **Click Rotate on the key.**

3. **Copy the new key from the one-time reveal.**

The old key stops working immediately.

4. **Update your integration before rotating in production.**

⚠ Rotation is instant — deploy the new key to your servers in the same change.

Sandbox vs live

What the sandbox tier can do and how to move to production.

1. **Check your current environment in the top bar.**

A pill next to the page title reads "sandbox" or "live".

2. **Build and test everything in sandbox first.**

Sandbox has the full API: merchants, offers, tracking links, click and conversion recording.

3. **Apply for production when you are ready to send real traffic.**

Use the "Apply for production access" banner at the top of the dashboard home page. During early access, applications are approved manually — you get an email when your workspace goes live.

A tour of the portal

What lives where in the publisher dashboard.

1. **Command — Home, Reports, Notifications.**

Your KPIs, charts, and account-level alerts.

2. **Identity & traffic — End-users, Identifiers, Links, Click events, Conversions, Campaigns.**

Everything about the people you refer and the clicks they generate.

3. **Inventory — Merchants and Offers.**

The cross-network catalogue you can promote, deduplicated across affiliate networks.

4. **Money — Payouts, Billing, API usage.**

What you have earned, your plan, and your request volume.

5. **Developer — Webhooks, API keys, Audit log.**

Integration and security tooling.
